

POLICY 8610
SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY

Individual members of the School Board are a member of a corporate body, representing the community, which makes policy decisions for the District. Accordingly, individual Board members have authority only when acting as a Board legally in session, except as otherwise provided by law or the School Board.

As a private citizen, a School Board member may express individual, unofficial viewpoints on any School Board action or decision, but does not have the right to make decisions or act or speak for the School Board without the prior authorization of the School
