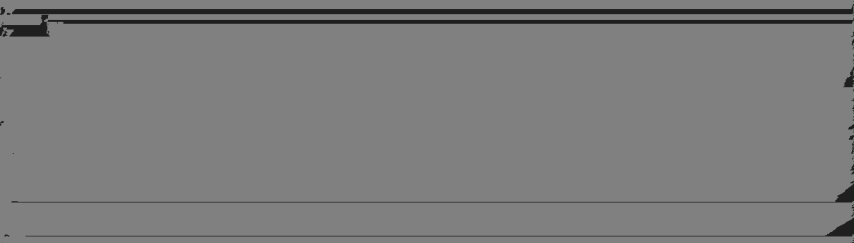
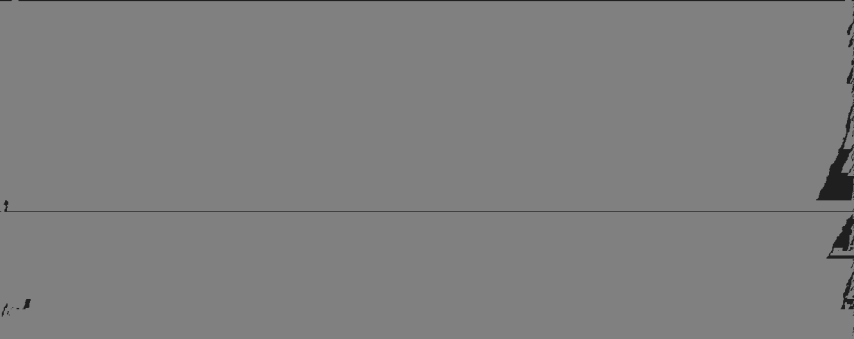

DURING EXTRACURRICULAR OR FIELD TRIPS

- 1. Any of the applicable rules or regulations will apply to any trip under school sponsorship.*
- 2. Pupils shall respect the wishes of competent chaperones appointed by the school officials to accompany the student bus riders.*
- 3. Teachers, chaperones and the bus driver shall confer before and after the trip on matters concerning the violation of the rules and regulations. The teacher or chaperone should verbally explain to the students the disciplinary action which could result from misconduct. Any violations should be in written form to the principal, by the teacher, chaperone or driver.*

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The driver shall be responsible for maintenance of order for school bus riders without physical or verbal assault. Misconduct considered serious by the driver shall be in written form to the principal for disciplinary action. If immediate disciplinary action is needed, the driver shall use the two-way radio to dispatch needed assistance by other authorities.*
- 2. Drivers and passengers are not allowed to smoke on the bus or on school grounds. The Clean Air Act of 1990, totally bans smoking in school buses with or without passengers. The School Board of the Kenosha Unified School District, bans smoking on all school property.*
- 3. The driver shall not allow any articles to be transported within the bus body if there is or may be interference with pupils or driver, or if aisle, well, or steps are obstructed.*

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
